

Dear Forestwood Figure Skating Club Member:

It's hard to believe that the summer is just starting and it's already time to start thinking about our upcoming skating season.

Our season is scheduled to start **Tuesday, September 8, 2009 and go through Thursday, April 1, 2010**. Attached you will find our Ice Schedule for the 2009-2010 season, and your ice contract. Please fill these forms out and return them to me at the address listed below as soon as possible; our season will start smoothly if all are registered well in advance of the first day of ice time. Mail your items to the address below, not the ice rink.

I would like everyone to know that the City of Parma has raised the rental rate we must pay for ice. The FFSC Board has worked diligently to keep figure skating an affordable sport for our participants. However, the fee increases are due only to the increased rate we must pay to the City.

You will notice there are a few minor changes to our schedule. We have added a new class called "Advanced Techniques." Personally, I am quite excited about this. This class will offer many opportunities for the skater to improve their skill in the sport. Each week there will be a new item that the skater can work on, including Artistry, Power, Edges, Jumps and Spins. The class will be taught each week by a different FFSC Professional. The Board has determined that this class would be an exciting class for any level of skater, from Basic 5 through a tested skater. It's a great way for the skaters to build friendships. Please remember if you wish to have your child participate in this class or want them to benefit from taking private lessons, the skater must be a full USFSA member.

We are also encouraging that skaters take advantage of contracting more than one session of ice. As you will see on our schedule, there will be a discount taken if your skater contracts more than one session of ice.

We have tentatively reserved Saturday March 27, 2010 as our Spring Exhibition Date. Our Skills class will again be highlighted in our Spring Exhibition as will those participating in our Advanced Techniques class. Presumably, there will be a mandatory dress rehearsal on Thursday March 25. If your child chooses to participate in our Exhibition, please remember that there will be a small fee assessed to participate. It is the FFSC Board of Directors mission to keep our costs as low as possible. More details will be available as the date nears. As a reminder ice bills must be paid in full by March 1, 2010 in order for your skater to participate in our Spring Exhibition.

Additionally, it has been decided by the FFSC Board to close for the 2 weeks during Christmas and New Year's. This cost saving measure for the club has been passed along to our skaters, making the season that much more affordable.

As a reminder, Janene Hatch is still, and always will be, looking for willing volunteers to work our stands at Progressive Field and Quickens Loan Arena. If you are interested in defraying the costs of skating, please contact Janene at [jmhatch2@juno.com](mailto:jmhatch2@juno.com) . This not only helps the club, but it helps with your skating bills.

We have a few fundraisers planned for the summer, and I would love to see everyone at them. Watch your email for announcements. (If you aren't receiving email please let us know!) Forestwood uses the proceeds from our fundraising efforts to help pay for the ice, which benefits you by keeping our rates down, so, your help and generosity is not only appreciated, but also benefits you!
